On this 3rd day of September Personally appeared before me Munson Colone of the judges of the Court of Common Pleas in and for said County Elyzer Miller a Resident of the Town of Windham County and State aforesaid Aged Seventy three years who being duly sworn according to Law ~~and~~ doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the Act of Congress passed June 7th 1839. That he enlisted in ~~the~~ army of the United States in the year 1777 at the Town of Richmond Berkshire County State of Massachusetts in ^{the} company commanded by Capt Aaron Rowley ~~in~~ the Detachment commanded by Major David Porter for one Month after arriving to the place of Destination which was Tiouderoga to which place he actually Marched from the before named Town of Richmond passing through ~~into~~ the State of Vermont to a place called Sheensborough then on down Lake Champlain on the Ice to Tiouderoga and served after arriving one Month under Colonel Wayne being then called from Richmond one hundred and fifty Miles having been about seven days on our way ~~thither~~ for which he was allowed over the Month service at the end of said term was discharged after Marching to the Town of Sareston in the State of Vermont by Major Porter

And also in the Summer 1777. Turned out in an
alarm under Capt Amos Kothbone from the said
Town of Richmond aforesaid to Columbia County
State of New York Six days - Dismissed at Henderson
in the said County of Columbia - and also turned
out under Sergeant Robert Casper in the said town
of Richmond and Marched to Williamstown
two days and there was dismissed - and also
in the same year from the said Town of Richmond
Turned out under Sergeant Casper from thence
Marched to Bennington in the State of Vermont
there put on guard to guard Prisoners to lanes
borough in the County of Berkshire State of Massa-
chusetts (these were Prisoners taken by General
Stark at Bennington) Five Days - and also
under the same Sergeant Casper marched from
Richmond aforesaid in same year of 1777. up
to Gates, Army in Saratoga State of New York -
and there joined Lieut. Reeves Stayed there five
or six days from thence was ordered to a place
called Tuller Mills on the East side of the North
River and there put into Capt Kothbone
Company under General Fellows there was
taken sick with the Camp Distemper and
Discharged by Lieut. Reeves having been out sixteen
days - also in year 1779. at the before named
