Cayuga COUNTY, ss. On this ~~2nd~~<sup>2nd day of ~~July~~<sup>Augst A. D. 1832
personally appeared in open Court, before the Court of Common Pleas in and for the County of Cayuga
and state of New-York, now setting, Ebenezer Phelps a resident of Bennett
in the County of Cayuga and State of New-York, aged Seventy two years, who
being first duly sworn, according to law, doth on his oath, make the following declaration, in order to obtain
the benefit of the act of Congress, passed June 7th, 1832: - That he entered the service under the following
named officers, and served as herein stated: - that about the last of August or first
of September A.D. 1776 at the town of Richmond in the County
of Berkshire in the State of Massachusetts he entered the Service
of the United States in the company of Militia commanded
by Captain Wright as he believes, Lieutenant -- Bolt in the
Regiment commanded by Col. -- Lincoln as he believes, that
he marched with said company to the White Plains in
the State of New York where he was discharged in the month
of November thereafter, having served about the term of
two months.</sup></sup>

He further declares that about the month of December
A.D. 1776 at the town of Richmond aforesaid, he again en-
tered the Service of the United States in the company of Militia
commanded by Captain Amos Rothburn in Col
~~Lincoln's~~ Regiment as he believes, that he marched
~~Stifffield in the state of Massachusetts from them to Albany and thence to Fort Edward for 10 days~~
with said company to Concord oroga in the State of New York
where he was discharged in the month of March 1777, having
served a term of three months.

He further declares that about the month of June A.D. 1777
at the town of Berkshire aforesaid he again entered the ser-
vice of the United States in the company of Militia coman-
ded by Capt. - . Aaron Howley (the name of his colonel he does
not now remember), that he marched with said company to
~~Berwick~~ Still Water in the State of New York in the month of July therefrom
having served a term of ~~about~~ weeks from thence to ~~Still Water~~
Shattock in the State of New York from thence towards White
Hall, and thence to Fort Anne, near where he continued
until he was discharged, that he was discharged at Still
Water in the State of New York aforesaid, having served a term
of about three weeks and returned home for the purpose of
